

Simmons Mill Pond Fishing Club Rules

Simmons Mill Pond Fishing Club members, family members and their guest acknowledge that they are aware of and voluntarily and freely agree to the terms and conditions of the “RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT” as made available to all persons entering properties and lake known as Simmons Mill Pond.

- 1- All members, family of members and guest are required to abide by Georgia Fish & Game rules and regulations regarding fishing and fishing from a boat.
- 2- Littering is strictly prohibited. Do not “sink” cans or bottles in the Lake.
- 3- No controlled substances (drugs) will be allowed on the property without a written prescription from a licensed physician.
- 4- Any person found on the property with an illegal substance (drugs) will automatically be denied further membership privileges with no refunds of membership payment.
- 5- Members will be held responsible for the activity and actions of their guest.
- 6- Membership Card must always be displayed on dash of vehicle while on property.
- 7- Discharging of firearms while on the property is prohibited.
- 8- Assigned member must accompany family members or guest.
- 10-Member may bring one guest per visit.
- 11-Only electric motors are allowed in the lake.
- 12-Boats may be left overnight or for an extended amount of time.
However, Simmons Mill Pond does not assume any responsibility for theft, damage or vandalism of boats or equipment.
- 13-If a boat is left for an extended time by a member that does not plan to renew the Membership Agreement, the boat must be removed on or prior to date of membership expiration. If not removed, management will remove and discard.
- 14-Cursing or abusive language within hearing of others is absolutely prohibited.

- 15-Care should be exercised to keep public awareness of drinking to a minimum. Beer cans and bottles (liquor, beer or wine) should be kept covered and/or out of sight.
- 16-Careful consideration along with a visual inspection should be made of your boat, trailer and motor before launching a boat that has been in another body of water. This will avoid importation of unwanted aquatic weeds.
- 17-Gill nets, traps of other forms of netting are prohibited.
- 18-Trout lines, limb lines and “jug type” fishing is prohibited.
- 19-Member must respect the Georgia Game and Fish Commission daily creel limit.
- 20-Night fishing is not allowed. Fishing is allowed from day break until dark.
- 21-On days of scheduled and properly noticed Duck Shoots, fishing will not be allowed until after 10:00 am.
- 22-No fishing is allowed within 50 feet of the spillway structure on the east side of raceway and pond or from the entire west bank of raceway.
- 23-No fishing is allowed within 75 feet of dock located in front of family residence west of the spillway.
- 24-Bank fishing in the pond is only allowed from the boat ramp to within 50 feet of the spillway.
